

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE FOR ORDINANCE NO. 2020-30 REGARDING THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2020, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2020-24, Face Covering Requirements, with a 30-day term that expired on September 24, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2020, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2020-30 which restated, amended, and extended the face covering requirements to 11:59 p.m. on October 31, 2020 and allowed future extensions of Ordinance No. 2020-30 to be passed by Resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds a continuation of the face covering requirements in Ordinance No. 2020-30 is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The expiration date of Ordinance No. 2020-30, entitled "Face Covering Requirements", adopted by the City Council on September 22, 2020, is hereby extended an additional month to 11:59 p.m. on Monday, November 30, 2020 unless otherwise extended or repealed prior to such expiration date.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption as provided by law.
