On 11/1/2020 at approximately 0219 hours, deputies responded to the area of Stickney Point Road and US 41 for the report of gunshots. A witness, Brent Lutz, reported hearing gunshots, followed by a car speeding off. A short time later the victim, [REDACTED] contacted the Sheriff's Office and reported he had been shot at by the defendant, Yestel Guerrero-Mata. [REDACTED] left the area of the incident and went to his residence in north Sarasota to meet with deputies. Deputies arrived at the residence a short time later and confirmed [REDACTED] vehicle had been struck by gunfire four times. During a recorded sworn statement, [REDACTED] advised he was leaving Rebellion Night Club, located at 6523 Gateway Avenue, in his [REDACTED] heading northbound on Gateway Avenue when he observed Yestel was following him in a gray 2006 Honda Accord. [REDACTED] stated Yestel pulled alongside the driver's side of his vehicle on Gateway Avenue and began shooting at him. [REDACTED] slammed on his brakes and Yestel continued northbound, at which point [REDACTED] proceeded northbound also then turned westbound on Stickney Point Road. Yestel continued to follow [REDACTED] on Stickney Point Road and pulled alongside the passenger's side of his vehicle once he caught up. Yestel then shot at [REDACTED] again in the area of Stickney Point Road and Avenue B, at which point [REDACTED] did a U-turn and got away by driving northbound on US41. [REDACTED] stated he was 100% positive Yestel was the subject shooting at him related to an ongoing feud. [REDACTED] was not injured during the incident but his vehicle sustained two holes on the driver's side, one on the passenger's side, two broken windows, and a cracked windshield. [REDACTED] advised that Yestel's girlfriend, Kennedy, was in the vehicle with him during the incident. [REDACTED] did not have a passenger with him.

On 11/2/2020, Yestel was located and taken into custody for a VOP warrant related to this case and was transported to the Sarasota County Sheriff's Office for an interview. His girlfriend, Kennedy Martinez, was also placed under arrest for an unrelated charge and interviewed as well.

During a Post-Miranda video recorded interview, Yestel corroborated much of [REDACTED] story aside from shooting at [REDACTED]. Yestel stated [REDACTED] was shooting at him and denied having a gun. Yestel admitted to chasing [REDACTED] even though [REDACTED] was allegedly shooting at him, but could not explain why. Yestel said he hit a curb, flattening his tire, at which point he parked his car in a Walgreens parking lot at US 41 and Stickney Point Road. Yestel stated his vehicle was not hit by any gunfire.

During a sworn video recorded interview, Kennedy stated she was in the passenger's seat of Yestel's vehicle when they left Rebellion and were directly behind [REDACTED]. She stated the two vehicles were side-by-side, at which point she laid back in the seat and heard four to five gunshots. Kennedy stated she did not see who was firing a gun.

Based on my investigation, I have determined probable cause does exist to charge Yestel J. Guerrero-Mata with Shooting into an Occupied Vehicle, Shooting a Firearm from a Vehicle within 1,000 feet of a Person and Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon pursuant to Florida State Statutes, 790.19, 790.15(2), and 748.021(1)(a) respectively.

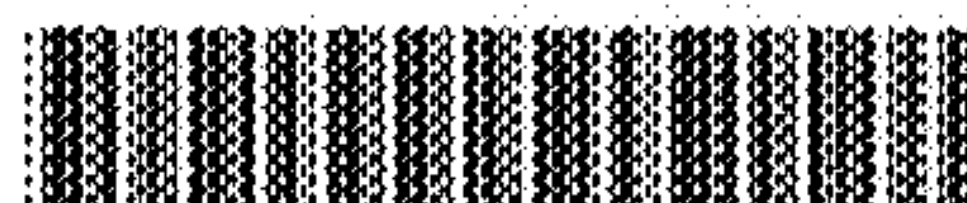
