**ORDER ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF COMMUNITY CONTROL
AND PROBATION**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant's community control and probation shall include the following conditions of F.S. § 948.30, and that this Order shall control if a conflicting order regarding conditions of probation is subsequently entered by this Court (except that the Court may make lawful modifications after notice to the Parties and a hearing):¹

 X (1)(b) If the victim was under the age of 18, a prohibition on living within 1,000 feet of a school, child care facility, park, playground, or other place where children regularly congregate.

 X (1)(d) A prohibition on any contact with the victim ~~or the victim's family~~, directly or indirectly, including through a third person, unless approved by the victim ~~and victim's family~~, a qualified practitioner in the sexual offender treatment program, and the sentencing court.


 X (1)(f) If the victim was under age 18, a prohibition on working for pay or as a volunteer at any place where children regularly congregate, including, but not limited to, schools, child care facilities, parks, playgrounds, pet stores, libraries, zoos, theme parks, and malls.

 X (4)(a) A prohibition on visiting schools, child care facilities, parks, and playgrounds, without prior approval from the offender's supervising officer.

¹ Pursuant to F.S. 800.101; 943.0435; and 948.30, the Court notes that the Defendant is not a sexual offender nor is Sexual Offender Probation required based on the nature of the charges.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to the agreement of the parties, the Defendant shall be able to petition this Court for modification of the terms of community control and probation, but he has agreed he shall not move to terminate community control nor probation early.
